Rules and Regulations

We're excited to invite you to nominate someone in your community for the Good Neighbour Hunt but first, here are the rules and guidelines to make sure everything runs fairly and smoothly.

1) Who can nominate?

- Any current BHA customer/tenant or member of a BHA household can submit a nomination.
- A neighbour of a BHA customer/tenant.
- BHA staff and board members are not eligible to be nominated.
- You can nominate more than one neighbour, but each must be nominated on a separate form.

2) Who can be nominated?

Any individual who:

- Lives in a BHA property or community.
- Has shown kindness, helpfulness or positive behaviour towards others.
- Is aged 16 or over.

3) What makes a good neighbour?

We are looking for people who:

- Regularly help or support others (eg. shopping, gardening, checking in on neighbours)
- Promote peace, safety and wellbeing in the community
- Show respect and care for the shared spaces
- Help reduce isolation, tension and anti-social behaviour

4) Entry deadline

All nominations must be received by Friday, 24 October 2025.

Late submissions will not be considered unless under exceptional circumstances.

5) Judging and selection

A panel will review all entries.

Finalists will be featured as part of BHA's Doorstep Stories campaign.

6) The Prizes

Winner will receive coveted Golden Doorbell Award, a prize hamper and public recognition.

Finalists will receive certificates, featured stories and small thank you gifts.

All nominees will receive a personal Thank you letter.

7) Consent and privacy

By submitting a nomination, you agree that:

- BHA may use your written submission and images for promotional purposes.
- You have the nominee's permission to share their story. (where possible)
- All data will be handled in accordance with BHA's Data Protection Policy and GDPR regulations.

8) Disqualification

BHA reserves the right to disqualify entries that:

- Contain false or misleading information.
- Include inappropriate, offensive or discriminatory content.

- Breach privacy without consent
